ABOUT CHI ALPHA

[Chi Alpha Christian Fellowship](#) (XA) is a community of students earnestly following Jesus. We're not a fraternity or a sorority (although we're a great place to find brothers and sisters). Our name comes from 2nd Corinthians 5:20 which says "we are therefore Christ's (Chi) Ambassadors (Alpha)."

We offer midweek worship services filled with music and Bible-based teaching from our pastor, [Glen Davis](#). In addition, Chi Alpha offers small group Bible studies (which we call Life Groups), outreaches, service projects, various social events, and informal gatherings also occur regularly. Chi Alpha is part of a [national movement](#) sponsored by the [Assemblies of God](#) and we welcome students from all backgrounds.

WHAT MAKES CHI ALPHA DIFFERENT?

What people tell us stands out about Chi Alpha is how diverse our community is, how vibrant our worship is, and how we emphasize the ministry of the Holy Spirit in each person's life. Also, we have a pastor who preaches every week, so if you like him that's a positive and if you don't that's a negative. :)

Having said that, there are several wonderful Christian groups at Stanford. Stanford is the size of a small town, and it even has its own fire department, police station, and post office. There are multiple ministries for the same reason a town has multiple churches. We love and support one another, and by the time you are an upperclassman you will have friends from all of the fellowships on campus.

WHAT DOES CHI ALPHA BELIEVE?

Our beliefs can be summed up simply:

- 1) God is real.
- 2) God has revealed Himself in Jesus.
- 3) The Bible is God's trustworthy message to us.
- 4) God still answers prayer.
- 5) God ought to be central to every person's life.
